During the installation of water mains, we ask that all customers notify the office of any problems or concerns that may arise, for example: road hazards or loss of water pressure. In an emergency situation such as the loss of water pressure, call:

During **ISOLATED BOIL WATER ADVISORIES**, the water company will post the advisory at each home affected. Each advisory will be identified by a number due to the fact that there may be more than one advisory active. **Updates on isolated advisories will also be posted on the Matamoras Municipal Authority door, on the Matamoras Municipal Authority answering machine and on the Matamoras EMA web site <http://www.matamorasema.com>**

In the event of an EXTREME water emergency such as a biological crisis, the Matamoras Emergency Management Agency will sound the emergency siren system. If the emergency siren system sounds (other than the normal siren test on the first Friday of each month at 1:00 pm) tune to the radio stations listed above.
